EMSA Eastern Division Highlights



- Y-T-D profit of \$272K compared to budgeted loss of \$154K
- Y-T-D collection rate of 49% vs budget of 49%
- Emergency transports are more than budget 502 transports or 3.1%
- Non-emergency transports were 243 more than budget or 10%

EMSA Western Division Highlights



- Y-T-D net loss of \$1,605K compared to budgeted net loss of \$1,717K
- Y-T-D collection rate of 51% compared to budget of 52%
- Emergency transports were more than budget by 1.3% or 233 transports
- Non-emergency transports were less than budget by 11% or 298 transports
