




1. Review of Quarterly Coding Audits


- As part of regular compliance monitoring, data is collected each quarter per the Coding Compliance Plan. The internal audit reviews modifiers, billing levels, and diagnosis coding.
 - i. Modifier Accuracy-98.4%
 - ii. Billing HCPC's Level Accuracy-99.2%
 - iii. Appropriate Diagnosis Coding Accuracy-97.6%
 - iv. Specialty Audit-Nursing Home to Hospital ALS-99%
 - v. Specialty Audit Hospital to Hospital ALS2-97%
 - vi. Specialty Audit Hospital to Hospital SCT-99.3%
