## **OIG/Level of Appeal Process**

- Draft Report received 10/2/2012.
- EMSA will answer the report within 30 days. (Answered 10/15/2012)
- The IG will then issue the final report, within 30-60 days. (11/15/2012 to 12/15/2012)
- EMSA has to decide either to refund the \$365,000 or allow it to draw interest.
- 1<sup>st</sup> Level of Appeal. While we have 120 days, we will appeal within 40 days from the final report. (12/15/2012 to 01/15/2013)
- 1<sup>st</sup> Level Appeal Decision. (1/15/2013 to 2/15/2013)
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Level of Appeal. Within 180 days following determination from 1<sup>st</sup> Level. We will file within 60 days. (2/15/2013-3/15/2013)
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Level of Appeal Decision. (3/15/2013 to 4/15/2013)
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Level of Appeal, QIC Reconsideration (This is a 3<sup>rd</sup> party vendor for Medicare), will file within 60 days. (4/15/2013 to 5/15/2013)
- QIC Reconsideration Decision. (05/15/2013 to 06/15/2013)
- If we have not elected to pay the funds back and are only accruing interest, 30 days following the QIC Reconsideration, Medicare will begin to offset the funds.
- 4<sup>th</sup> Level of Appeal, ALJ Hearing, must be filed 60 days from the 3<sup>rd</sup> level decision. (06/15/2013 to 07/15/2013)
- ALJ Hearing findings, 90 days. (07/15/2013 to 08/15/2013)

## At any time if appeals are overturned, the payment is returned plus interest back to EMSA.

Note: Most Appeals are not overturned until it at least gets to the 3<sup>rd</sup> Level, the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Level is reviewed by the Medicare contractor, and the 3<sup>rd</sup> Level is an independent review. The contractor never likes to admit they are wrong.
