Subject: FINANCIAL REVIEW – May 2013

Attached you will find financial statements for May 2013. The financial statements are presented on a combined basis and for each division. Also included are *Key Financial Indicators*, *Transports and Requests for Service*, *Cash Rollforward*, and *Capital Expenditures Variance*. Please note that the financial statements are unaudited.

Highlights

On a year-to-date basis, the Eastern Division had a net loss of \$2,316 thousand compared to a budgeted loss of \$1,236 thousand, and the Western Division had a net loss of \$7,372 thousand compared to a budgeted net loss of \$8,397 thousand.

There is no net interdivisional payable/receivable as of 5/31/13.

Combined Balance Sheets

Following is a discussion of significant assets and liabilities at May 31, 2013, and how the balances have changed from the prior year.

Other Miscellaneous Receivables

The East balance represents the amount owed from the utility fund based on ordinance criteria and also amounts owed by granting agencies.

Due to Contractor

The due to contractor balance represents our liability to Paramedics Plus for May and April services. This balance usually includes two months of contractor billings.

Deferred Revenue

The deferred revenue balance consists of TotalCare revenue that has not yet been amortized and the contractor's gain sharing amount that has not been credited against the expense account.

Income Statements

Following is a discussion of operating revenues and expenses that vary significantly from budget.

Patient Service Revenue

Eastern division gross revenue exceeds budget by \$1,443 thousand (1.8%) and Western exceeds budget by \$3,554 thousand (4%).

Gross patient service revenue variances are partly attributable to differences between actual and budgeted transports for fiscal 2013. The Eastern Division had 829 more emergency transports than budgeted (1.6%); non-emergency transports were 185 less than budget (2.2%). The Western Division emergency transports were more than budget by 1,803 (2.8%) and non-emergencies were 1,560 more than budget (116%).

The financial statements are being significantly impacted by the difference between the unit hour cost sharing percentages that were budgeted and those realized to date. YTD the East percentage is 2% higher and the West 2% lower than budget. The YTD impact on contractor costs is approximately \$875,000 and \$125,000 on other allocated costs. The percentage rates have trended closer to budget as the year has progressed and are expected to settle in the 47/53 percent range for the remainder of the year.

The year-to-date collection rate is 56% for the Eastern Division compared to a budget of 48% and an actual for fiscal 2012 of 59%. The year-to-date collection rate is 55% for the Western Division compared to a budget of 46% and an actual for fiscal 2011 of 59%. The positive collection rate for the East is misleading as even though it is in excess of budget, actual cash receipts are below budget. The collection rate is calculated as actual cash receipts divided by potential cash receipts. The estimate of potential cash receipts was overstated.
