911 BLS Program

June 2022-July 2022

- Eastern Division/Metro Tulsa
- Eligible Calls (MCB MPDS Codes) = 2365
 - BLS Ambulance Responses = 303 (12.8%)
- Overall Transports = 1641
 - Cancel/Refusal of Service 30.6%
- RLS Transports = 21 (**0.88%**)
- ALS Assists = 17 (**5.6%**)
- Unstable VS = 64 (**2.7%**)



911 BLS Program

June 2022-July 2022

- Western Division/Metro OKC
- Eligible Calls (MCB MPDS Codes) = 1962
 - BLS Ambulance Responses = 261 (13.3%)
- Overall Transports = 1378
 - Cancel/Refusal of Service 29.77%
- RLS Transports = 13 (**0.66%**)
- ALS Assists = 9 (**3.45%**)
- Unstable VS = 49 (**2.5%**)



911 BLS Program

Dec 2021-July 2022

- Metro Oklahoma City & Tulsa Combined
- Eligible Calls (MCB MPDS Codes) = 16508
 - BLS Ambulance Responses = 1685 (10.21%)
- Overall Transports = 11313
 - Cancel/Refusal of Service 31.47%
- RLS Transports = 145 (**0.88%**)
- ALS Assists = 60 (**3.56%**)
- Unstable VS = 394 (**2.39%**)
