EMSA Eastern Division Highlights



- Y-T-D loss of \$299K compared to budgeted loss of \$1,298K
- Y-T-D collection rate of 52% vs budget of 49%
- Emergency transports are more than budget 2,155 transports or 4.5%
- Non-emergency transports were 999 more than budget or 13%

EMSA Western Division Highlights



- Y-T-D net loss of \$3,263K compared to budgeted net loss of \$6,089K
- Y-T-D collection rate of 51% compared to budget of 52%
- Emergency transports were more than budget by 2% or 912 transports
- Non-emergency transports were less than budget by 12% or 963 transports
