 - Establish Non-911 BLS EMT credential primarily hospital to home/nursing home transports
 - Currently all credentialed are on contract status

 - Immediately suspend any MPDS Code for safety
 - Immediately suspend program for safety
 - Report to MCB via email and at next MCB
- Ongoing every 2-month analytics by EMSA due by 15th of following month to MCB/OMD with reports at MCB meetings to follow
