 - 2003 Codes
 - No changes indicated by CY2022 + historical analysis

911 BLS Program

Dec 2022-Jan 2023

- Eastern Division/Metro Tulsa
- Eligible Calls (MCB MPDS Codes) = 2298
 - BLS Ambulance Responses = 530 (23%)
- Overall Transports = 1620
 - Cancel/Refusal of Service 29.5%
- RLS Transports = 19 (0.8%)
- ALS Assists = 11 (0.5%)
- Unstable VS = 61 (2.7%)



911 BLS Program

Dec 2022-Jan 2023

- Western Division/Metro OKC
- Eligible Calls (MCB MPDS Codes) = 1775
 - BLS Ambulance Responses = 281 (15.8%)
- Overall Transports = 1329
 - Cancel/Refusal of Service 25.1%
- RLS Transports = 19 (1.1%)
- ALS Assists = 12 (0.7%)
- Unstable VS = 43 (2.4%)



911 BLS Program

Feb - Mar 2023

- Eastern Division/Metro Tulsa
- Eligible Calls (MCB MPDS Codes) = 2212
 - BLS Ambulance Responses = 885 (40%)
- Overall Transports = 1585
 - Cancel/Refusal of Service 28.3%
- RLS Transports = 13 (0.6%)
- ALS Assists = 38 (1.7%)
- Unstable VS = 56 (2.5%)



911 BLS Program

Feb - Mar 2023

- Western Division/Metro OKC
- Eligible Calls (MCB MPDS Codes) = 1758
 - BLS Ambulance Responses = 58 (3.3%)
- Overall Transports = 1273
 - Cancel/Refusal of Service 27.6%
- RLS Transports = 16 (0.9%)
- ALS Assists = 11 (0.6%)
- Unstable VS = 50 (2.8%)



911 BLS Program

Dec 2021-Mar 2023

- Metro Oklahoma City & Tulsa Combined
- Eligible Calls (MCB MPDS Codes) = 32822
 - BLS Ambulance Responses = 6032 (18.4%)
- Overall Transports = 22878
 - Cancel/Refusal of Service 30.3%
- RLS Transports = 301 (0.92%)
- ALS Assists = 214 (0.65%)
- Unstable VS = 891 (2.71%)



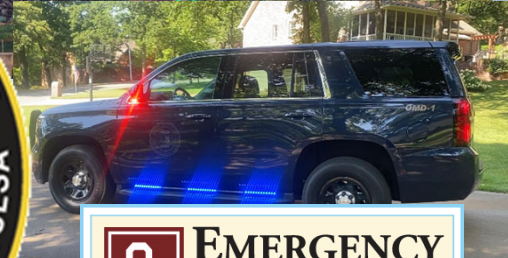
OMD Activities Ahead
